Angus and Amy realize evacuating isn't a real solution because the cycle will repeat. How will they get the food and resources? Hope to find another civilization that will sell them snacks? Leader Guy begins to despair about what he's done. Amy comforts him. We can work together and solve this. Angus says, "When I'm stuck, I ao see...'

"...Grandma!" Smash-cut to the front of Angus' grandmother's house, a small, homey cottage. Angus explains how their planet is at risk and her rage grows. She knows it's all Leader Guv's fault, that he and his company made her community move into a cramped neighborhood. They used to produce all of their food on their farms, but now they live in such a small space they're forced to buy additional foods. Angus and Amy agree that Leader Guy has messed up, but if they don't work together, they'll all have to leave the planet and the cycle may repeat. Grandma Mayble sighs and agrees to help. "Never underestimate a Grandmother's love for her grandchildren. I'll help you, but good luck getting everyone else involved. And believe me, we can't do this alone."

CHAPTER 6

Grandma Mayble begins to teach them about farming (Including Leader Guy). The group learns sustainable processes for farming and nurturing the earth. CHAPTER 7


